## ~Did you know?~

- The average carrot travels over 1800 miles to get to your dinner plate.
- About 93% of your food dollar pays processors, packagers, distributors, wholesalers, truckers and the rest of the infrastructure that a global food system demands.
- An American Gardening Association survey showed a 19% increase in hobby country farms and urban edible gardens from 2008 to 2009.
- Gardening for 45 minutes burns as many calories as 30 minutes of aerobic exercise.
- Preschool children served home-grown produce are more than twice as likely to eat five servings of fruits and vegetables a day as kids who rarely eat home-grown produce.
